
Here’s a taste of what’s in store at the open house:

- A trading simulation at the Rotman Financial Research and Trading Lab.



In the only competition of its kind in North America, approximately 125 students from across Canada and the US come together at Rotman to test their thinking using business + design methodologies. The competition is judged by representatives that include members of design consulting firms.

{(RITC)} Rotman International Trading Competition February 23 - 25



Faculty and students from forty universities worldwide are coming to Rotman for RITC, the premier trading competition of its kind. Competing teams will undertake simulated market trading challenges.
